ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

Birsa Munda was a prominent tribal leader and freedom fighter born on November 15, 1875, in the Khunti district, Jharkhand. He belonged to the Munda tribe and dedicated his life to fighting for the rights of indigenous communities against colonial suppression. He Born to Sugana Munda and Karmi Hatu, farmers who worked hard to sustain their family amidst colonial rule and social discrimination. He Spent his childhood in poverty and was influenced by the rich cultural heritage and spiritual practices of the Mundas. He Emerged as a charismatic leader who mobilized the tribal population to resist colonial oppression and assert their rights. He led the Ulgulan (Great Tumult) movement, also known as the Munda rebellion, to fight



against the British oppression on tribal communities in the Chhota Nagpur region. Advocated for tribal rights, land ownership, social justice, and opposed forced labour, exploitative taxation, and oppressive debt bondage. Birsa Mundas also remembered as "Dharti Aba" (Father of Earth) for his efforts to protect tribal rights, culture, and land. He also Inspired subsequent tribal and anti-colonial movements across India. he died on June 9, 1900, at the age of 25, while in British captivity. His birth anniversary is celebrated as Janjatiya Gaurav Divas to recognize the contribution of tribal independence activists. A museum was inaugurated at the Old Central Jail of Ranchi, where Birsa Munda took his last breath, featuring the Statue of Rebellion. The objective of this seminar aims to highlight Birsa Munda's contribution to the Indian independence movement and his fight for tribal rights.
