## ABOUT THE SEMINAR :

Ideas, innovations, and creative expressions on the basis of which the public is ready to confer the status of property have been classified as intellectual property rights (IPR). Effective Intellectual property (IP) protection has been a critical factor in deciphering the translation of academic research beyond the boundaries of tertiary educational institutions such as universities. Industries have always been on top of this; however, academia is seriously playing catch-up in investing in IPs. This workshop is aimed at addressing this 'missing middle' awareness of IP, which would facilitate translational research.

The participants would understand how to make use of technology transfer mechanisms within and between organizations, to protect and commercialize IP generated through R&D.

IP databases are critical resources which are generally not utilized by academic researchers. This workshop aims at bridging this gap and providing hands-on training on how to search patents using popular IP databases such as Google Patents, USPTO, Espacenet, WIPO, etc.

Attendees would also be given information on their own rights and responsibilities regarding IP generated through their own research and the commercialization options available for innovations from academic researchers.

## ABOUT IPR CELL :

Intellectual Property Cell was established on 26-07-2011 at Ch. Charan Singh University, Meerut after proper approval of the Council for Science & Technology, UP, Lucknow vide D.O. No. 165 dated 19 April 2011, with a mission to create awareness and guidance for academic and non-academic staff, students, and scholars of Ch. Charan Singh University and its affiliated colleges/institutes, as well as outside agencies i.e., police, industries, and the judiciary, on the practices and the rules for protecting all forms of intellectual property rights (IPRs) (Patent, Copyright, Design, Trademarks, Know-how, etc.) and obligations within the framework of the IPR policy of the University.

The University IP shall be managed by the IPR Cell. The IPR Cell will also take appropriate and sufficient steps to commercialize the intellectual property, which in turn will lead to the creation of a fruitful and dynamic system between universities, investors, and industries. Moreover, the IPR Cell will ensure continuous and perpetual knowledge transfer amongst students and faculty alike.

- ❖ **"IP and AI : Navigating the Intersection of Innovation and Artificial Intelligence"**: Explores the emerging legal and ethical issues related to AI-generated inventions and IP protection.
- ❖ **"IPR for Startups and Entrepreneurs"**: A business-focused approach on leveraging IPR to establish market presence, attract investors, and increase company valuation.
- ❖ **"Geographical Indications: Opportunities and Challenges"**: Discusses the protection of products linked to specific regions and their economic potential.
- ❖ **"IP Litigation and Enforcement Strategies"**: Focuses on the legal avenues available for IP owners whose rights have been infringed upon, including case studies.


## ABOUT MEERUT CITY :

Meerut is one of the most important town in the northern part of India. The town, situated in Western Uttar Pradesh, has a long history behind it. The city was a part of the Hastinapur Empire of the Kauravas, who ruled Vedic India and were the protagonists of the Hindu epic Mahabharata. Meerut is the fastest developing city of Uttar Pradesh after Noida and Ghaziabad. Meerut ranks 4th in terms of population in Uttar Pradesh. It is an ancient city located 56 km(35 mi) north-east of New Delhi. Meerut also has one of the biggest army garrisons/cantonments in this part of the country. It is famous for its scissors, sports goods, and gazak. Meerut is also known as the sports capital of India, and with the availability of 3,500 hectares of industrial land and the proximity to Delhi, it is developing as an industrial hub. Meerut, with its eminent history and luxuriant picturesque backdrop, has a well-developed tourism sector. ## COMPETITION GUIDELINES

There will be four competitions conducted during the seminar: **Debate, Quiz, Slogan, and Poster**. Each competition is designed to encourage participants' creativity, knowledge, analytical skills, and innovation. Each competition will have four prizes: **1st Prize – ₹10,000/- (Ten Thousand Only), 2nd Prize – ₹8,000/- (Eight Thousand Only), 3rd Prize – ₹5,000/- (Five Thousand Only), and 4th Prize – ₹3,000/- (Three Thousand Only)**.

### Common Rules for All Competitions:

1. The competitions are open to P.G./Ph.D. students of the University, affiliated colleges, and recognized organizations across Uttar Pradesh.
2. One student/delegate can participate in only one competition.
3. Judges' decisions are final and binding.
4. No offline registration will be entertained; all registrations must be completed online.
5. Participants must maintain discipline, clarity, and respectful behaviour during the competitions.
6. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to modify any rule if required.
7. Winners will be informed via email or phone, or announced at the conclusion of the event, & will be awarded prizes.

## DEBATE COMPETITION

The Debate Competition is designed to promote critical thinking, effective communication, and informed discussion among participants. It provides a platform to present well-researched arguments and diverse perspectives on the seminar theme in a structured and engaging manner.

### DEBATE COMPETITION - RULES & GUIDELINES :

1. Arguments must strictly be based on the approved seminar theme (IPR, Innovation & Entrepreneurship).
2. The debate will be conducted in English and Hindi.
3. Each speaker will be **given 4 - 6 minutes**. Exceeding the time limit may lead to penalties.
4. Participants must strictly follow the allotted speaking order.
5. Arguments should be original, relevant, and supported by facts or reliable sources. Plagiarism is not allowed.
6. Logical and respectful rebuttals/refutations are encouraged.
7. Use of mobile phones or electronic devices during the debate is not permitted.

## SLOGAN COMPETITION

The Slogan Competition aims to encourage creativity and originality among participants by expressing innovative ideas in a concise and impactful manner. The competition provides a platform to highlight awareness and understanding of the seminar theme through powerful and meaningful slogans.

### SLOGAN COMPETITION - RULES :

1. The slogan must be original and created by the participant.
2. Only one entry per participant is allowed.
3. The slogan should not **exceed 20 words**.
4. The content must be relevant to the given theme.
5. Use of offensive, inappropriate, or copyrighted content is strictly prohibited.
6. Participants should not mention their name or any personal identification in the slogan.
7. Entries must be submitted through the prescribed online form/email only.
8. Plagiarism will lead to disqualification.

## QUIZ COMPETITION

The Quiz Competition aims to test participants' knowledge, analytical skills, and quick thinking on topics related to the seminar theme (IPR, Innovation & Entrepreneurship). It provides an interactive platform for students and research scholars to demonstrate understanding, recall facts, and apply concepts in a competitive yet engaging environment.

### QUIZ COMPETITION - RULES :

1. The quiz will be conducted in English.
2. Questions will cover topics related to IPR, Innovation, Entrepreneurship, and Transfer of Technology
3. Electronic devices or notes are not allowed during the competition.
4. Participants must listen carefully and respond within the given time limit for each question.
5. The use of unfair means or plagiarism will lead to disqualification.
6. Points will be awarded for correct answers; negative marking may be applied for wrong answers (if specified).

## **POSTER COMPETITION**

The Poster Competition aims to encourage creativity, artistic expression, and effective communication of ideas on the seminar theme (IPR, Innovation & Entrepreneurship). Participants will have the opportunity to visually represent concepts, highlight innovative thinking, and showcase originality through engaging and informative posters.

### **POSTER COMPETITION - RULES :**

1. The competition is open to P.G./Ph.D. students of the University, affiliated colleges, and recognized organizations across Uttar Pradesh.
2. **Posters must be in physical form** with A3 size (Length: 297 mm x Width: 420 mm). For digital posters, high-resolution images at 300 PPI are required.
3. **Pre-prepared poster** as per seminar theme must be placed in the designated area for evaluation.
4. Participants must submit an abstract of the poster (maximum 500 words).
5. **Hand-made posters** must be original; photographs, print-outs, or 3D objects are not allowed. Acceptable tools include pencils, crayons, water colour, and oil paints.
6. Name, class, affiliation/college, email, and mobile number - must be clearly indicated on the poster.
7. A short oral explanation (up to 5 minutes) of the poster must be given before the judges. Judges may ask questions after the presentation.
8. Poster must relate clearly to the seminar theme. Judges look for unique and creative ideas and execution.
9. Artistic composition includes design, layout, color choices, and overall quality. Information should be easy to understand and logically organized.
