OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Study visit of the Joint Committee on the Constitution (129th Amendment) Bill, 2024 and The Union Territories Laws (Amendment) Bill, 2024 to Panaji (Goa) and Lucknow (Uttar Pradesh) from 10 to 15 July, 2026.

The undersigned is directed to state that the Joint Committee on the Constitution (One Hundred and Twenty-Ninth Amendment) Bill, 2024 and the Union Territories Laws (Amendment) Bill, 2024 will undertake a study visit to Panaji and Lucknow from 10 to 15 July, 2026 and will hold discussions with the stakeholders as decided by the Committee. A copy of the study-visit programme is enclosed at Annexure-I.

2. The composition of the Joint Committee, both in Hindi and English, is enclosed at Annexure-II. The names of the Members of the Committee who will be undertaking the Study Visit and officers of the Secretariat, who will be accompanying the Committee, would be intimated in due course. However, in the meantime, arrangements for 39 Members of the Committee and 05 Officers of the Lok Sabha Secretariat may be made. As per rules, Members/Officers of the Committee are entitled to reach two days before the commencement of the visit, i.e. from 08 July 2026 at Panaji and stay two days after the conclusion of the visit i.e. upto 17 July 2026 at Lucknow.

3. The Ministry of Law and Justice alongwith other organizations are requested to make necessary arrangements for the Study Visit of the Committee as under:-

(i) The expenditure on boarding, lodging, transportation, etc, for Members and Officers accompanying the JPC shall be borne by the host organization as per the guidelines (Annexure-III). As per the revised study visit guidelines of this Secretariat which came into force w.e.f. 21 August, 2020, expenditure incurred on Parliamentary Committees during their study visits is to be borne by host Organisations/Government bodies concerned as was the practice prior to 2004.

(ii) The details of the administrative arrangements to be made by each Nodal Department at each place of visit in consultation and coordination with other concerned Departments/ Undertakings/ Organisations have been enumerated in (Annexure-IV).

(iii) It should be ensured that all the necessary facilities are provided befitting the status of Members of the Committee and that the place of stay/room is clean and tidy and no inconvenience is caused to the Committee. The State Governments at the respective station are requested to extend all cooperation and assistance to the aforesaid Nodal Ministry to ensure smooth conduct of the study visit.

4. The Nodal Ministry/Departments/Organizations/PSUs concerned shall ensure the presence of the Heads of the respective organizations and other senior officers identified for interaction at the places of visit, and necessary instructions in this regard may be issued to the concerned authorities in advance. They shall also depute one serving senior officer, not below the rank of Joint Secretary or equivalent and well versed with the provisions of the Bill, to remain present during the Committee's discussions. The State Governments of Panaji and Lucknow may be represented by the Chief Secretary/Secretary along with the senior-most officers of the concerned Departments. In cases where the Head of the organization is unable to attend due to unavoidable and genuine reasons, prior permission of the Chairperson shall be obtained for deputing the other senior officer to represent the organization.

5. The Ministry of Law and Justice shall also identify and furnish details of various reputed stakeholders viz, Bar Councils/Universities/ Former Chief Justices and Judges of High Courts, Constitutional experts and other stakeholders, if any, with whom interaction is to take place at the places of visit/discussion. The Ministry shall also ensure that minute to minute programme for each station is provided to the Secretariat well in advance.

6. The State Governments of Goa and Uttar Pradesh are requested to furnish lists of eminent personalities from their respective states, who have excelled in public administration sports, entertainment industry and social services etc. along with the contact details thereof, for inviting them to interact with the Committee.

7. The Ministry/Department/Organization/PSUs concerned are further requested to communicate the arrangements made for the stay, visits and discussions, etc., of the Committee to this Secretariat latest by the Thursday, 25 June 2026. The liaison Officers of the nodal Departments at Panaji and Lucknow will be the Chief Liaison Officers at that place and would coordinate with other Departments/ Undertakings/ Organizations for the arrangements at that place/station.

8. In this connection, the guidelines to be followed by the Chief Liaison Officers at Panaji and Lucknow are given in Annexure-V. These guidelines are to be meticulously followed by the Chief Liaison Officers at each station to make the stay of the Committee comfortable and convenient.

9. All the Ministry/Department/organization/PSUs are further requested to nominate Nodal Officers at Delhi as well as at Panaji and Lucknow for coordination purpose. The names, designations and telephone/mobile/Whatsapp/Fax numbers of the Nodal Officers so nominated may kindly be intimated to this Secretariat latest by 25 June 2026 for the information of the Chairperson and Members of the Committee. The authorities concerned at these places may kindly be asked to communicate the arrangements made for the stay, visits and discussions, etc. of the Committee to this Secretariat by 25 June 2026.

10. The Ministry/Department/organization/PSUs should ensure to furnish without fail a list of names, designations, Organization of the representatives/officers who would be present at the time of discussions with the Committee to the officers of this Secretariat accompanying the Committee, immediately on their arrival at the respective places of visit. They are also requested to ensure that name plates of the Members of the Committee and officers (indicating name and designation) as well as their own representatives are displayed at the venues of the sittings and adequate public address system is put in place. Further, it must be ensured that the Guidelines as contained in the Annexure - III and V are meticulously followed by all concerned associated with the Study Visit programme, at the places of visit.

It may be noted from the Study Visit Programme that the Committee will be holding discussions with representatives of the Ministry/Department/organization/PSUs/State Government and other stakeholders, etc. at the respective places to be visited by the Committee. These discussions with the Committee shall be confidential and it shall not be permissible for the participants in discussions or anyone who may have access to the proceedings to communicate directly or indirectly to the press or any unauthorized persons any information regarding the proceedings. The Ministry of Law and Justice are, therefore, requested to issue necessary instructions to the concerned Chief Secretaries as well as Chief Liaison Officers at Panaji and Lucknow in this regard.

The Ministry of Civil Aviation/Airports Authority of India Ltd. are also requested to nominate Liaison Officers at New Delhi, Panaji and Lucknow to facilitate smooth movement and flight boarding of the Members and officers of the Committee as per the enclosed Study Visit Programme at Annexure-I.
